

WEST FRANKFORT REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
TUESDAY, APRIL 24, 2018

1. MAYOR JORDAN CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AT 6:00 P.M. REQUESTING A ROLL CALL. ALL COMMISSIONERS WERE IN ATTENDANCE, ALONG WITH THE CITY ATTORNEY AND CITY CLERK.

2. MAYOR JORDAN ASKED FOR APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 30, 2018 SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING AND THE APRIL 10, 2018 REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING. COMMISSIONER HARKINS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CHAMBERS. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL COMMISSIONERS AND MAYOR JORDAN VOTED TO APPROVE. MOTION CARRIED.

3. MAYOR JORDAN NEXT ASKED FOR APPROVAL TO PAY CITY BILLS AND PAYROLL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$297,813.81. COMMISSIONER SIMPSON MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CHAMBERS. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL COMMISSIONERS AND MAYOR JORDAN VOTED TO APPROVE. MOTION CARRIED.

4. THE NEXT ITEM WAS APPROVAL OF A PROCLAMATION DECLARING MAY 10, 2018 THROUGH MAY 13, 2018 AS THE WEST FRANKFORT OLD KING COAL FESTIVAL. COMMISSIONER SIMPSON MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HARKINS. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL COMMISSIONERS AND MAYOR JORDAN VOTED TO APPROVE. MOTION CARRIED.

5. THE NEXT ITEM WAS APPROVAL OF A PROPOSAL FROM CAPE ELECTRICAL SUPPLY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,598.92 TO REPLACE 2 PARKING LOT LIGHTS NEAR WEST SIDE ENTRANCE TO THE WEST FRANKFORT MALL. COMMISSIONER CHAMBERS MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER SIMPSON. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL COMMISSIONERS AND MAYOR JORDAN VOTED TO APPROVE. MOTION CARRIED.

6. THE NEXT ITEM WAS APPROVAL OF A PROPOSAL FROM CARL VOLANSKI HEATING AND AIR CONDITIONING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,860.00 TO REPLACE TWO MALFUNCTIONING HEATERS AT THE WFBI. COMMISSIONER SIMPSON MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HARKINS. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL

COMMISSIONERS AND MAYOR JORDAN VOTED TO APPROVE. MOTION CARRIED.

7. THE NEXT ITEM WAS APPROVAL TO TRANSFER LAKE LOT LEASE #2 FROM KENT HERRON TO KENT A. HERRON, TRUSTEE AND CHERYL A. HERRON, TRUSTEE, OF THE KENT AND CHERYL HERRON REVOCABLE LIVING TRUST. COMMISSIONER BLADES MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER CHAMBERS. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL COMMISSIONERS AND MAYOR JORDAN VOTED TO APPROVE. MOTION CARRIED.

8. BUILDING AND SIGN PERMITS:

I HAVE A REQUEST FOR A BUILDING PERMIT SHE IS REQUESTING TO PUT UP A FREESTANDING CAR PORT BESIDE HER HOUSE 16 X 22. THE COST FOR THIS BUILDING PERMIT IS \$17.66. COMMISSIONER BLADES MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER HARKINS. ROLL CALL VOTE: ALL COMMISSIONERS AND MAYOR JORDAN VOTED TO APPROVE. MOTION CARRIED.

THERE WILL BE A PUBLIC MEETING MONDAY APRIL 30, 2018 AT 5:30 ON THE BUDGET AND THEN AND A SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING AT 6:00 TO APPROVE THE BUDGET. WE ARE ALSO GOING TO VOTE ON THREE ADDITIONAL HOUSES THAT HAVE BEEN DEMOLISHED WE ARE TAKING BIDS ON THOSE.

10. COMMISSIONER COMMENTS:

COMMISSIONER CHAMBERS STATED I JUST WANT TO THANK ROGER AND THE STREET DEPARTMENT. A COUPLE MEETINGS AGO THE RESIDENTS CAME TO TALK ABOUT FLOODING AT CRAWFORD AND LINDELL AND THEY HAVE BEEN DOWN THERE AND DUG ALL THE DITCHES IN THAT TWO BLOCK RADIUS OR SO. THERE ARE A FEW AREAS THAT WERE RENTAL PROPERTIES AND THE RESIDENTS HAD

TALKED ABOUT THE DITCHES BEING FILLED IN WHICH CAUSED SOME FLOODING. ROGER REACHED OUT TO THE LANDLORD AND HE HAS AGREED TO LET US PUT DITCHES BACK IN AND RESOLVE ALL OF THAT. I THINK WE HAVE GOTTEN ALL OF THEIR PROBLEMS FIXED OR THEY ARE IN THE WORKS OF BEING FIXED.
